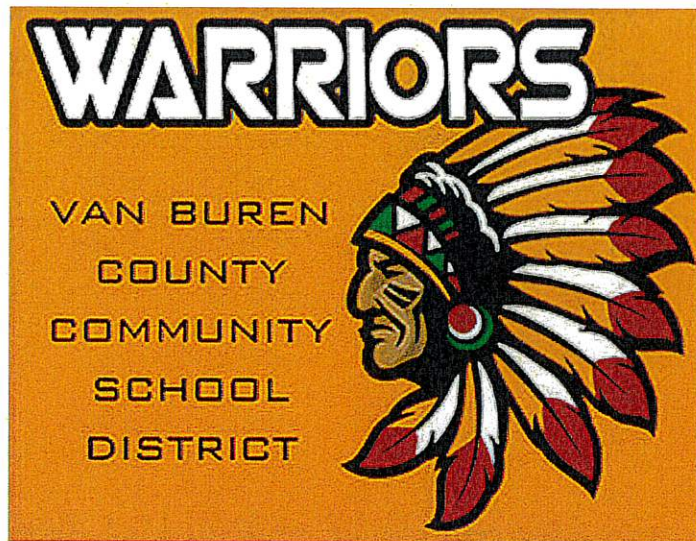

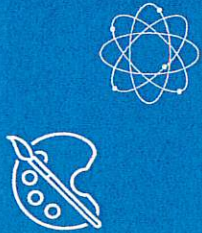
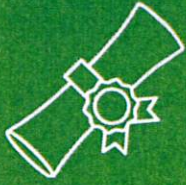

	4 YEAR Bachelor's Degree	• Undergraduate Degree in a wide range of academic majors • Examples: Iowa State, University of Iowa, University of Northern Iowa
	LIBERAL ARTS	• Has an emphasis on undergraduate study in liberal arts and sciences • Examples: Grinnell, Cornell, Coe, Wartburg
	2 YEAR Associate's Degree	• Also called Community College / Junior College • Offers many types of educational programs that lead to degrees / certifications and serve as job-entry educational experience • Examples: Indian Hills, Iowa Central, Kirkwood
	TECHNICAL / VOCATIONAL	• Also known as trade school or career college • Focuses exclusively on job training needed for a specific career or skilled trade • Examples: Midwest Technical Insitute, Siouxland Pipe Welding School, PCI Academy
